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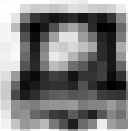

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Abstract: The purpose of this study was to investigate the effect of a 12-week training program on the physical and psychological health of sedentary middle-aged women. The study was conducted in a community center in a city in the north of Iran. The sample consisted of 30 women, aged 40-50 years, who were randomly selected from a list of women living in the community center. The women were divided into two groups: a control group (n=15) and an intervention group (n=15). The intervention group participated in a 12-week training program consisting of three sessions per week, each lasting 45 minutes. The training program included aerobic exercises, strength training, and flexibility exercises. The control group did not participate in any training program. Data were collected at baseline and after 12 weeks. The results showed that the intervention group had significant improvements in physical and psychological health compared to the control group. The intervention group had significantly higher levels of physical activity, lower levels of body mass index (BMI), and lower levels of anxiety and depression. The control group had no significant changes in these variables. The results of this study suggest that a 12-week training program can improve the physical and psychological health of sedentary middle-aged women.

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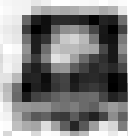

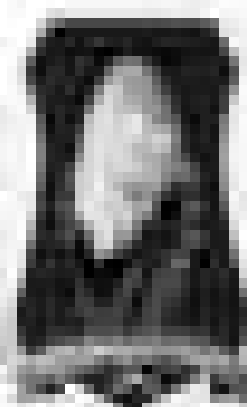

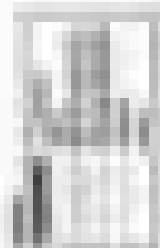
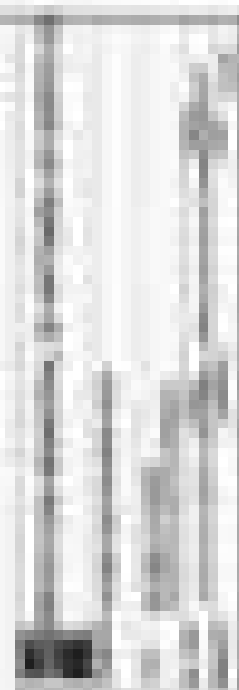
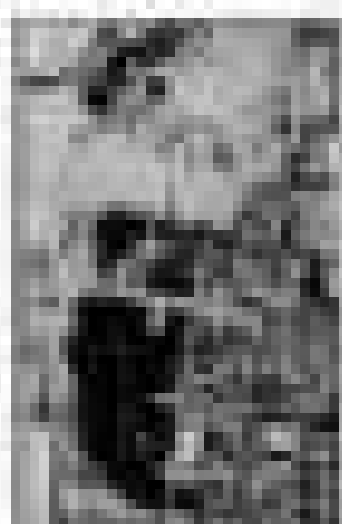
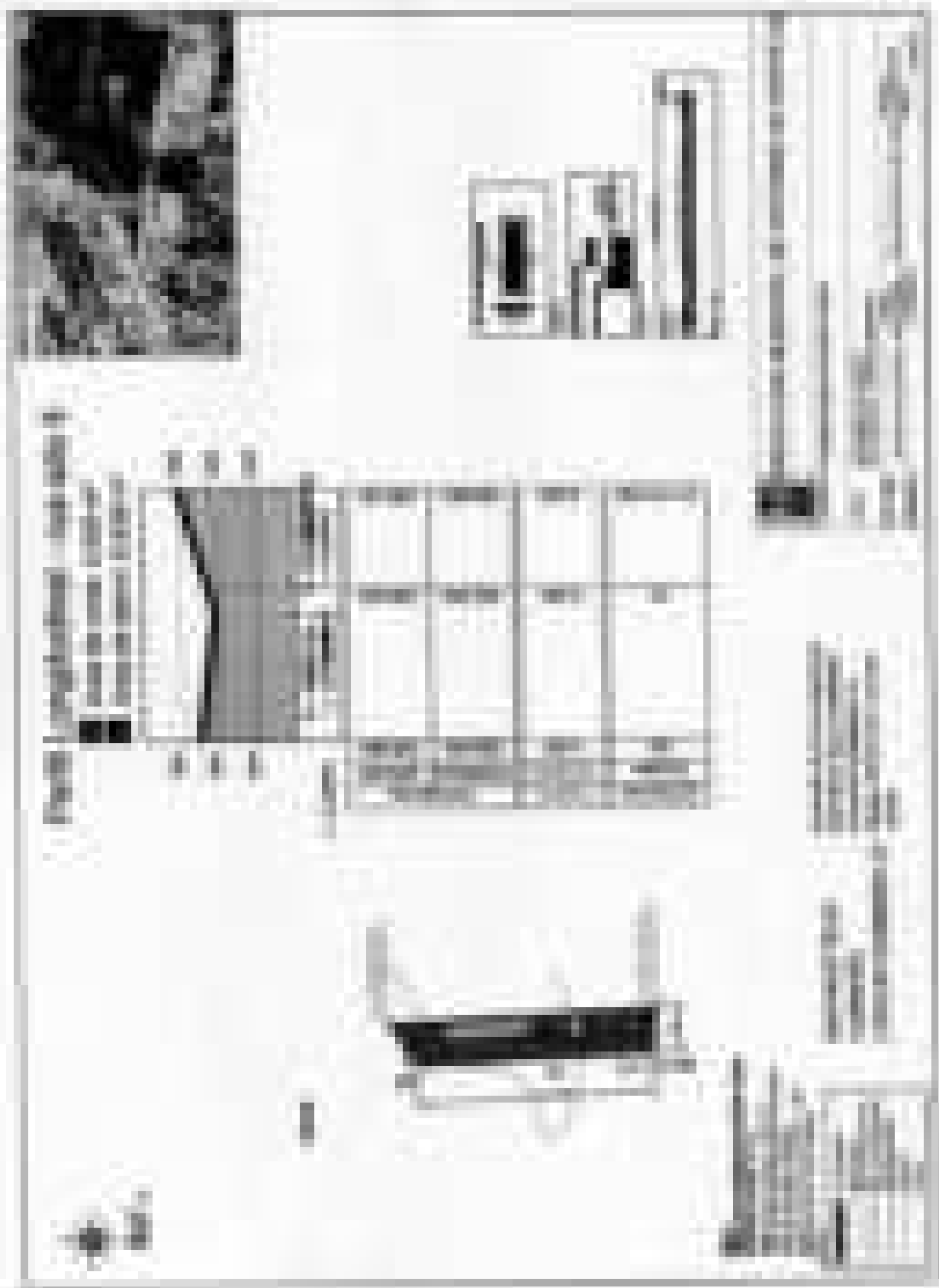
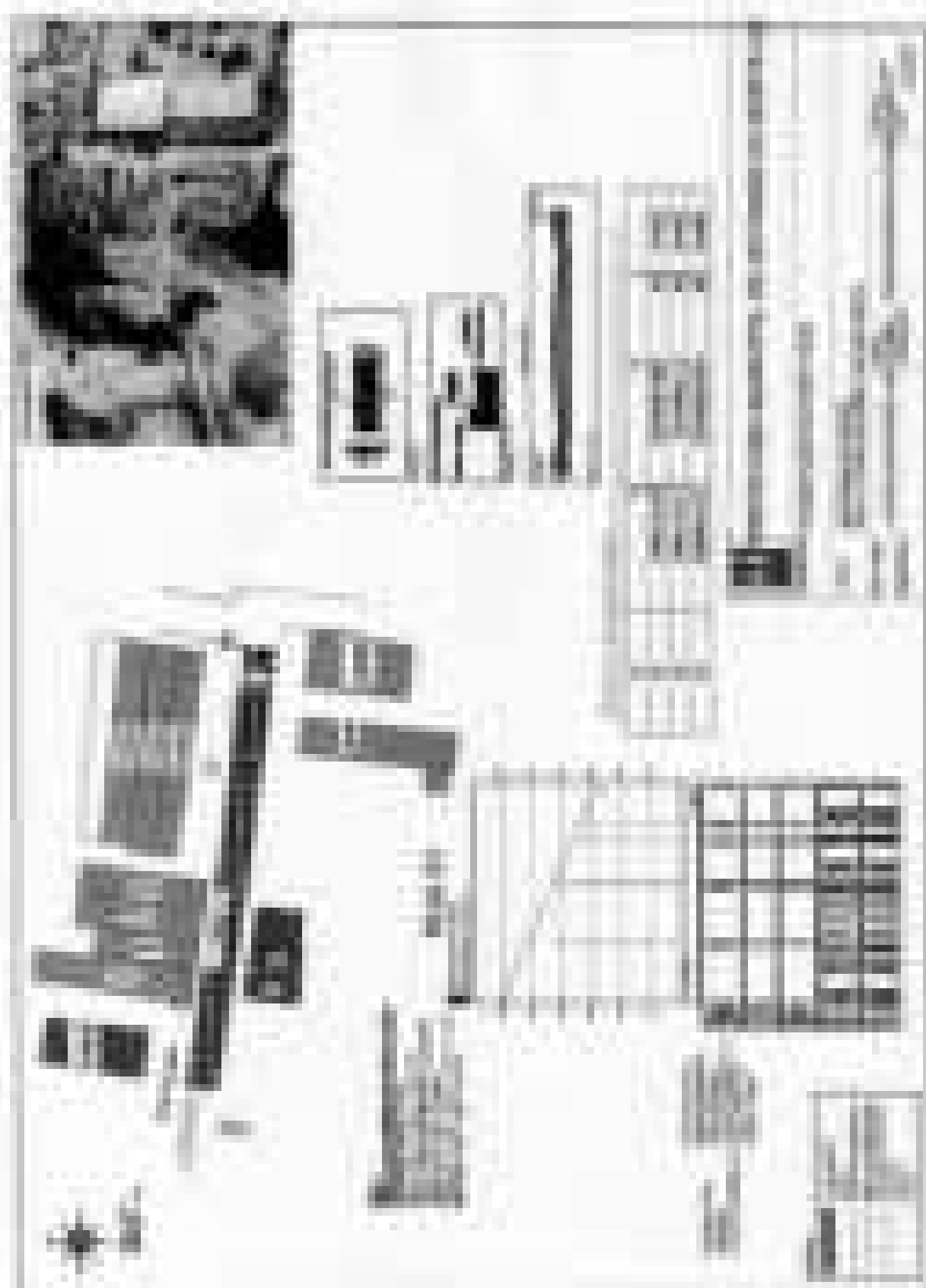
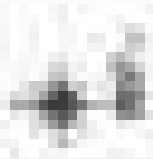
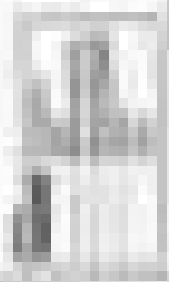
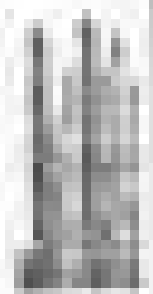
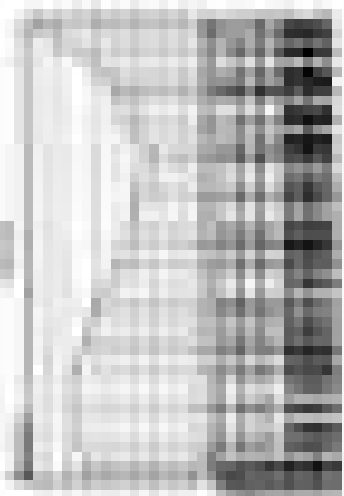
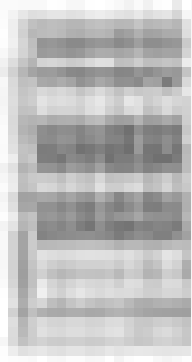
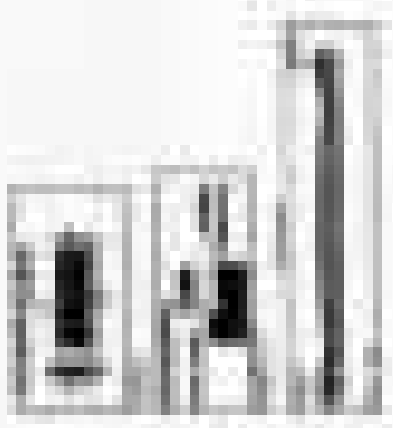
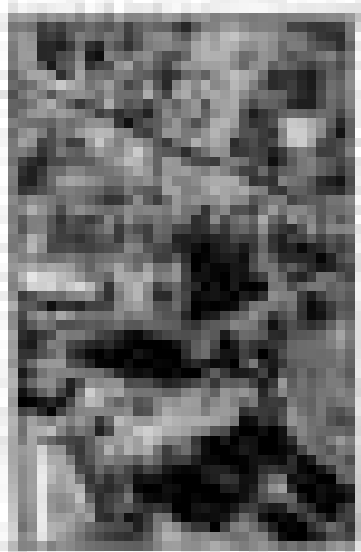




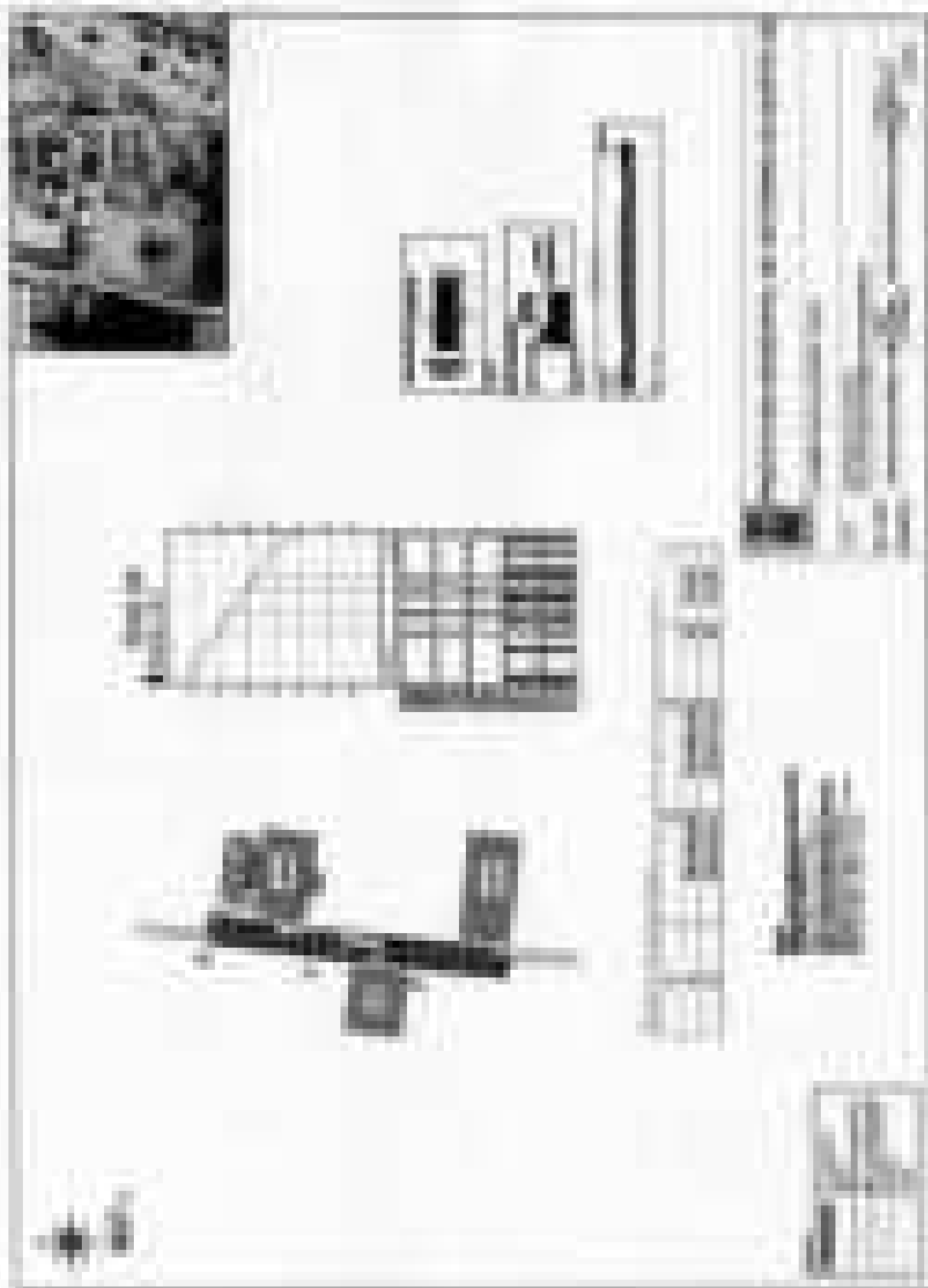
Figure 1. Aerial photograph of the study area showing the location of the study site (indicated by a black line) and the surrounding landscape.

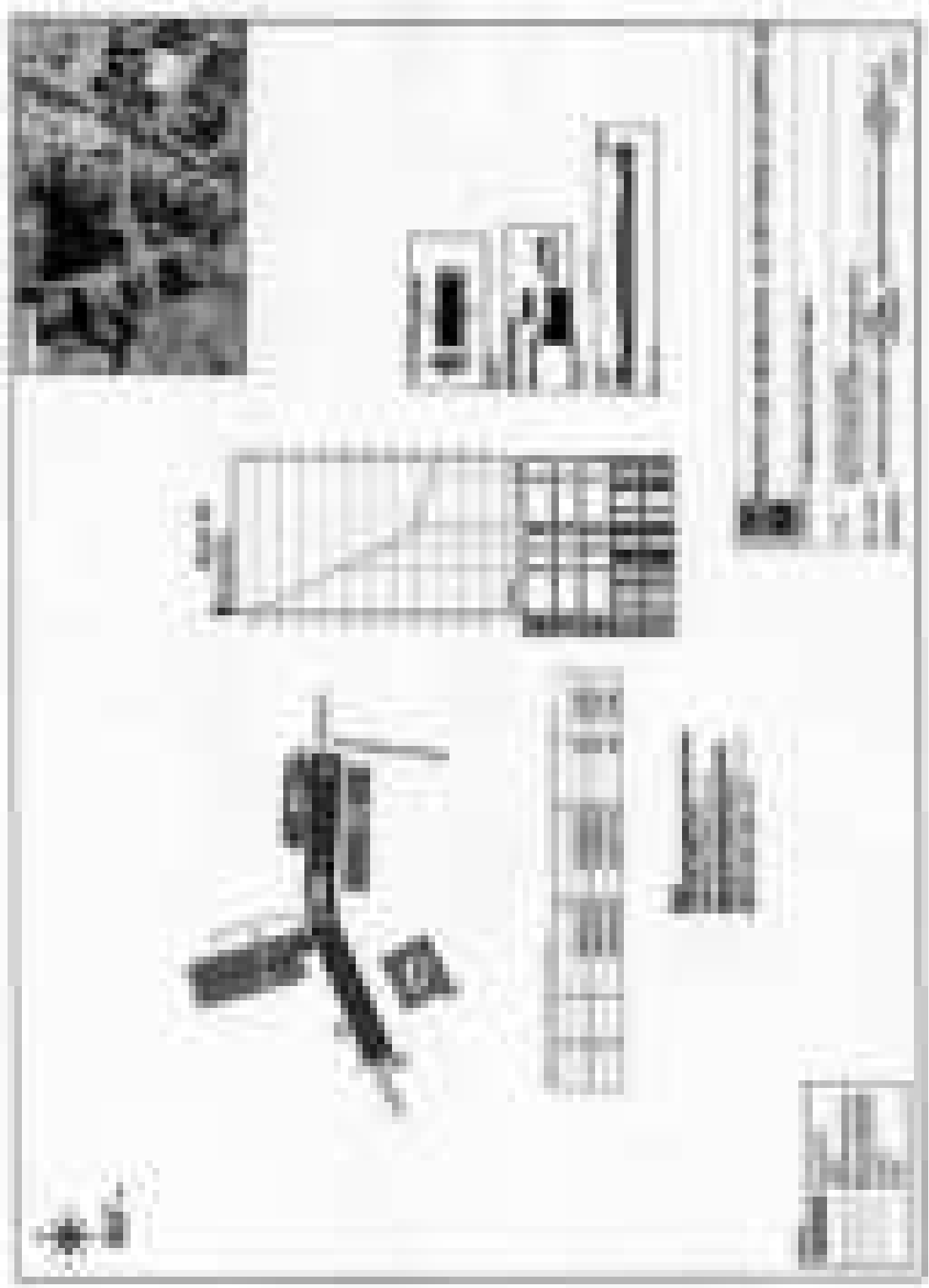


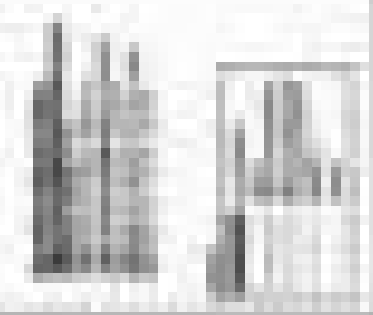
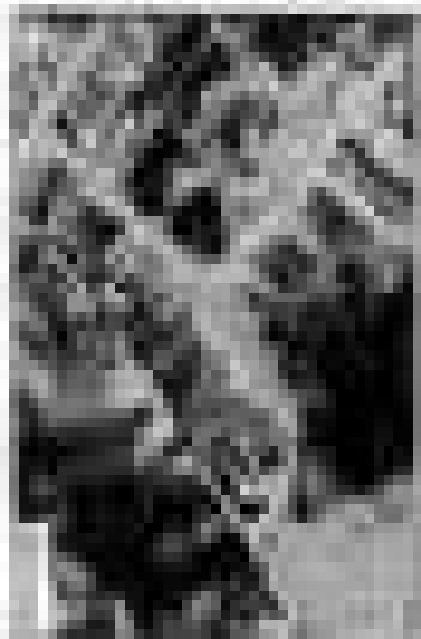


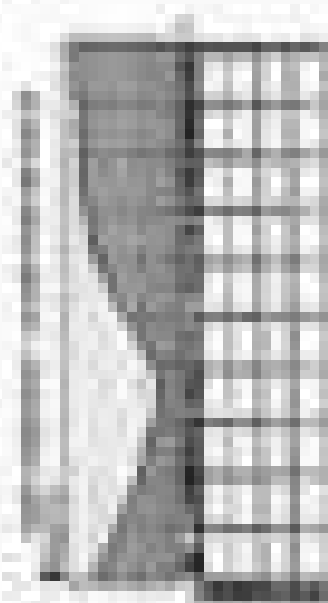
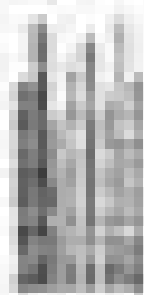
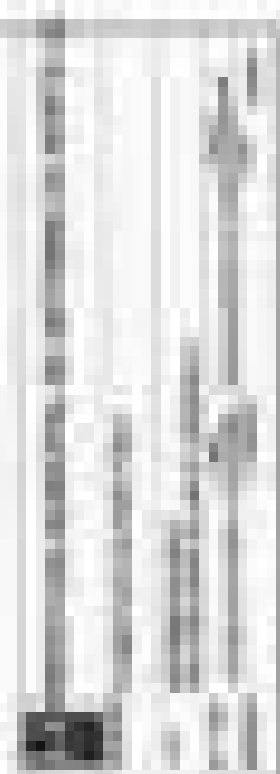
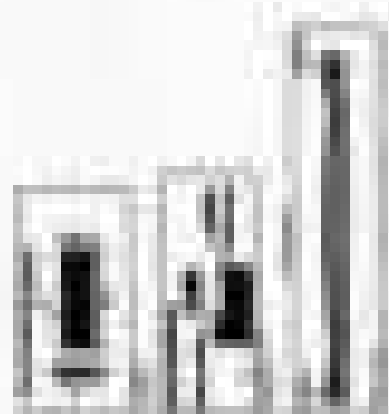
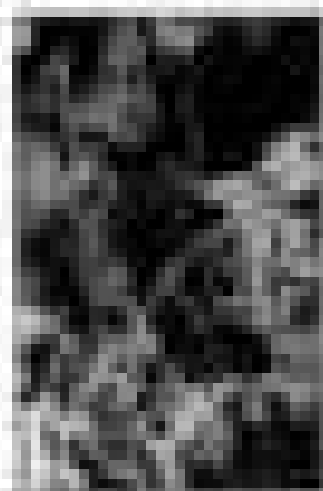


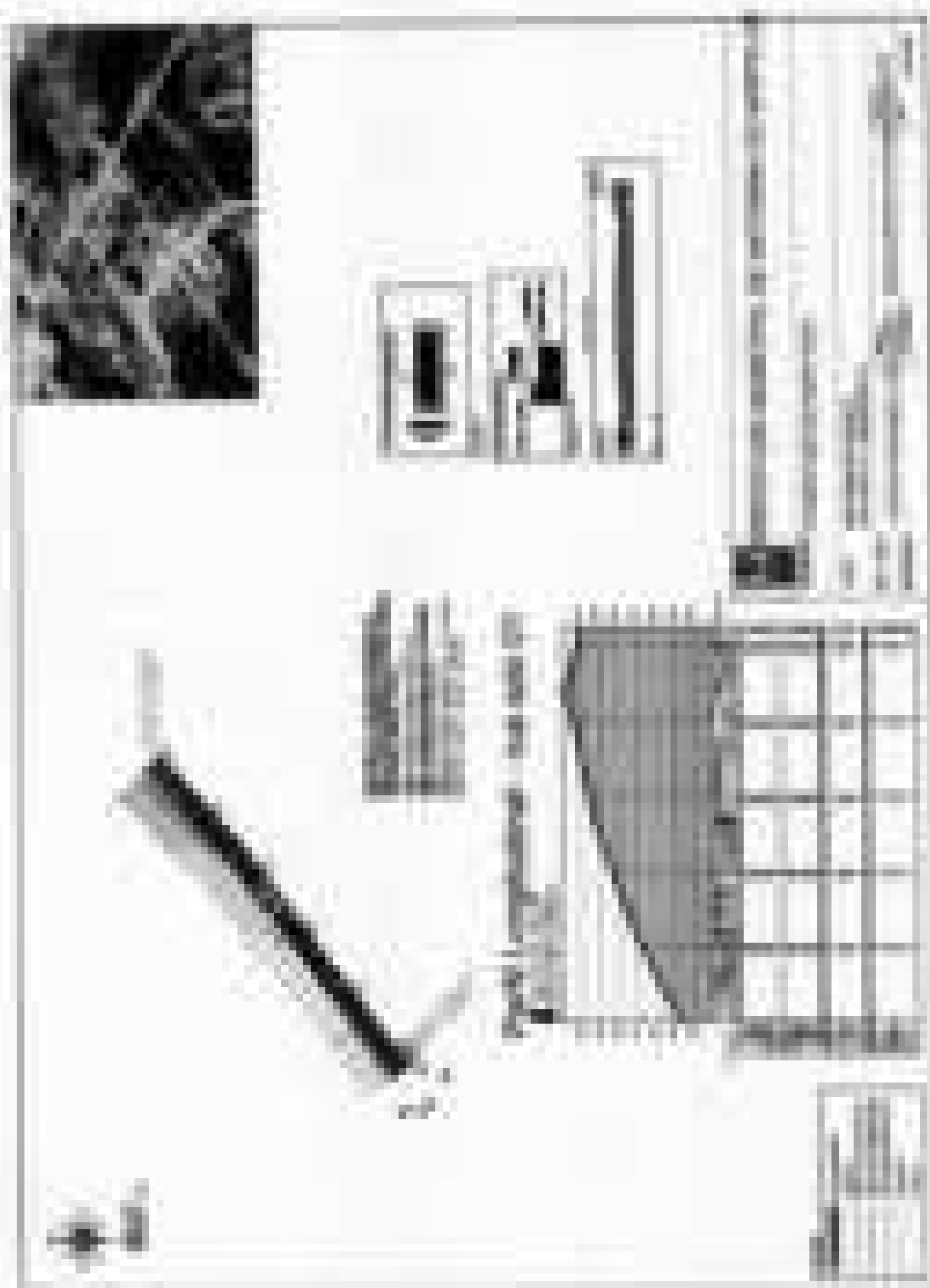


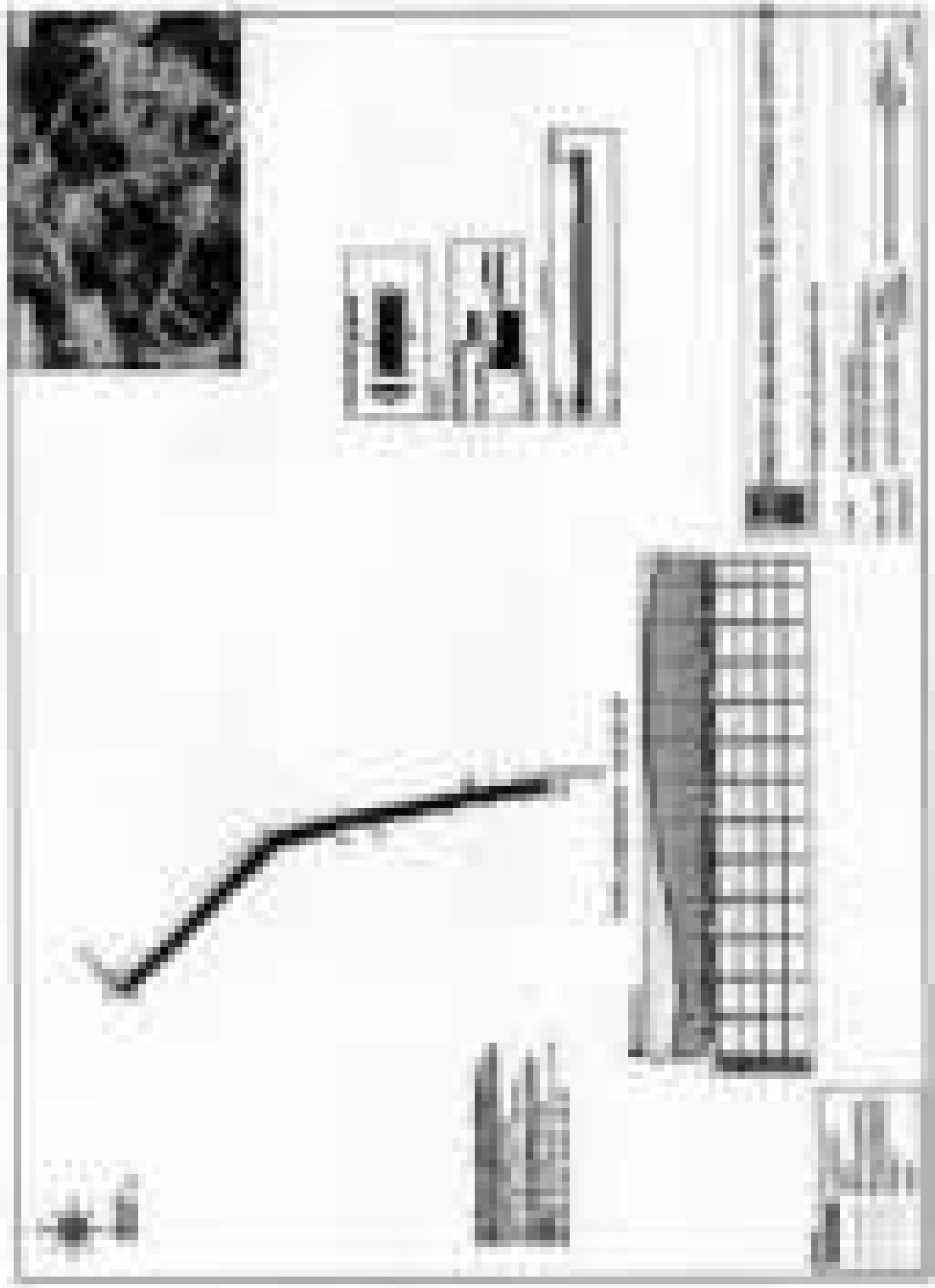


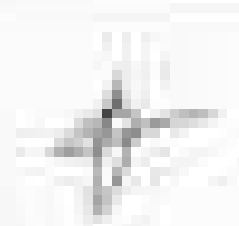
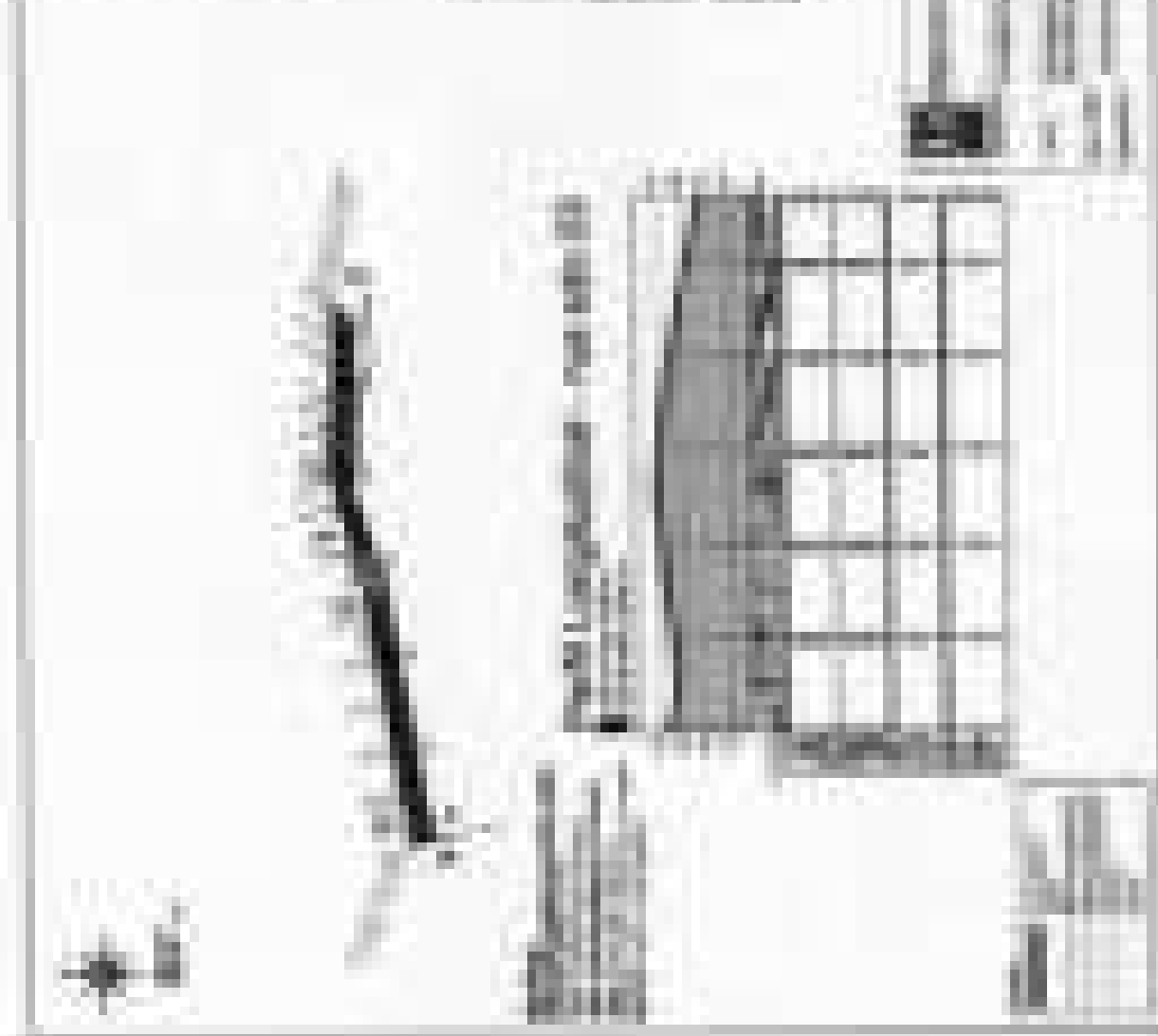
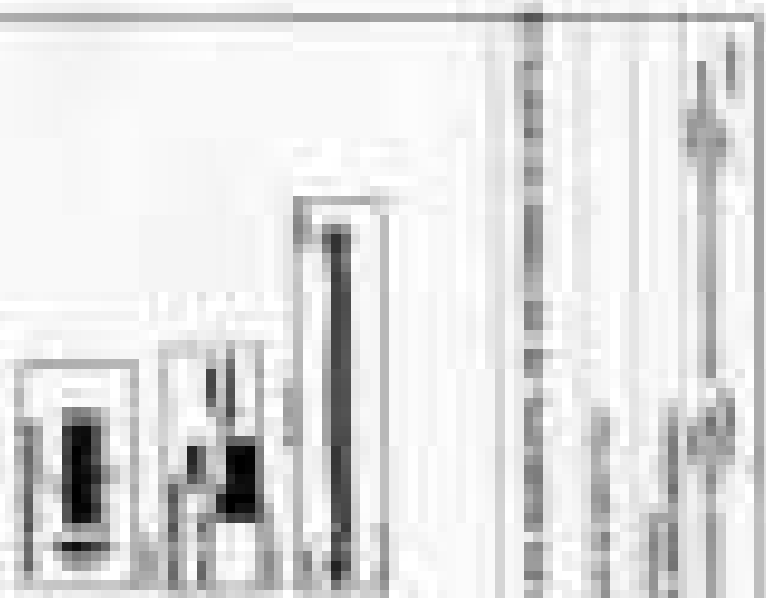
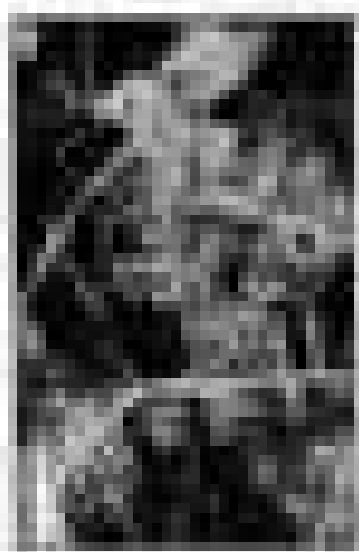


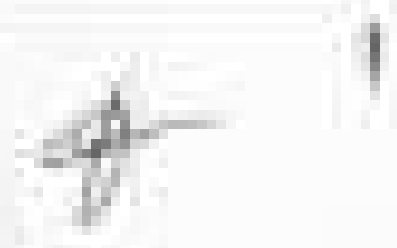
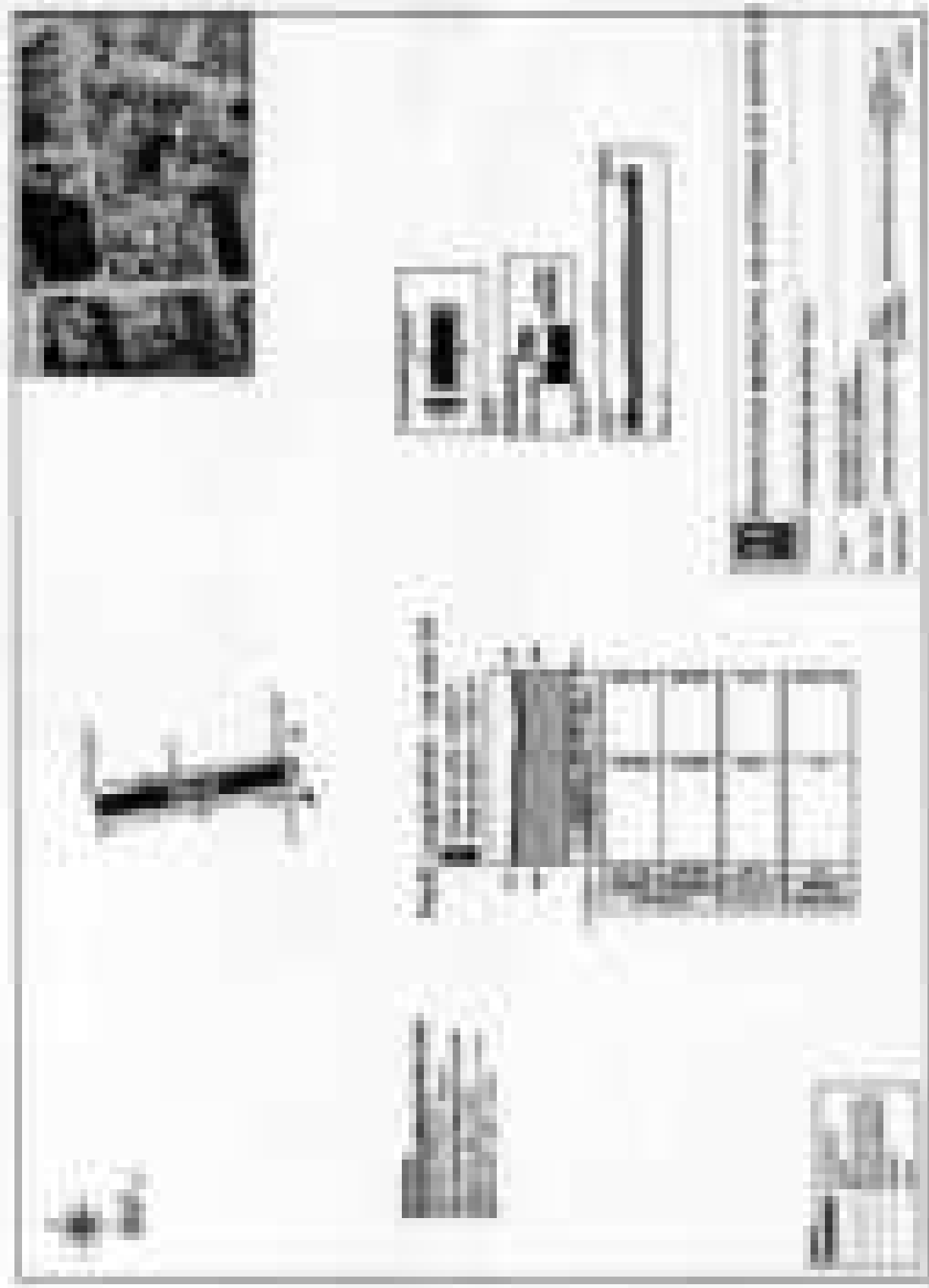


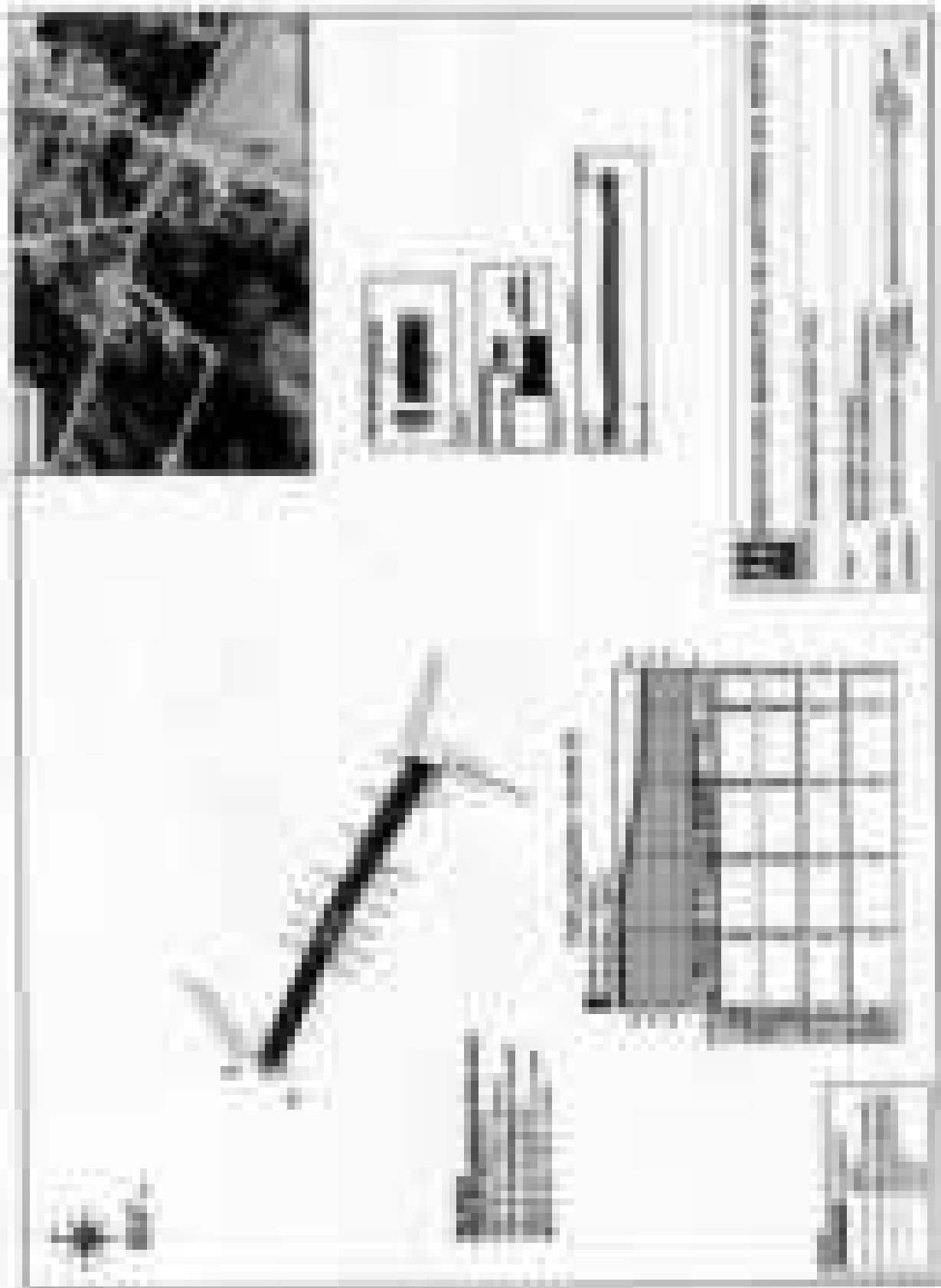


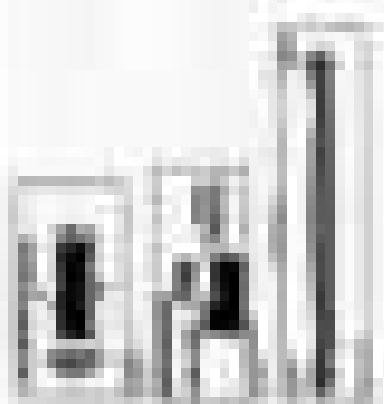
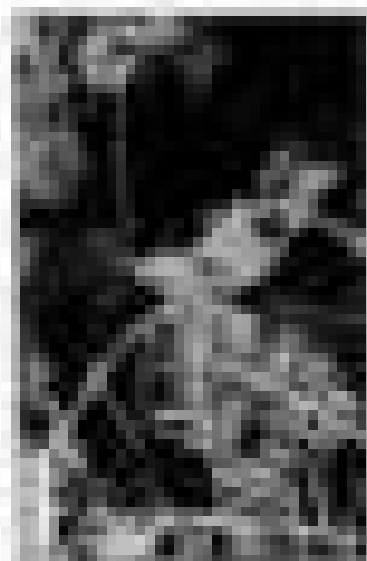


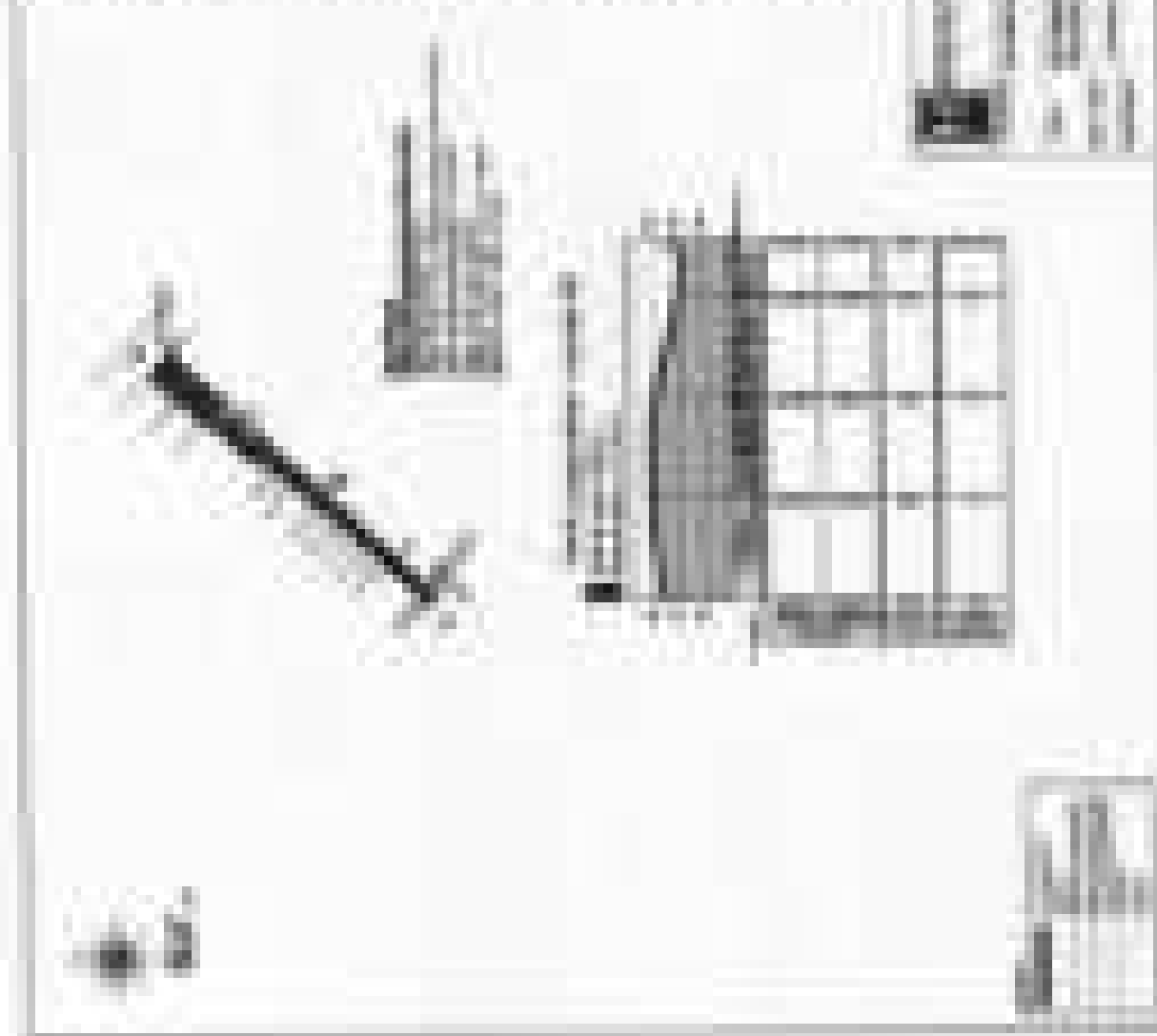
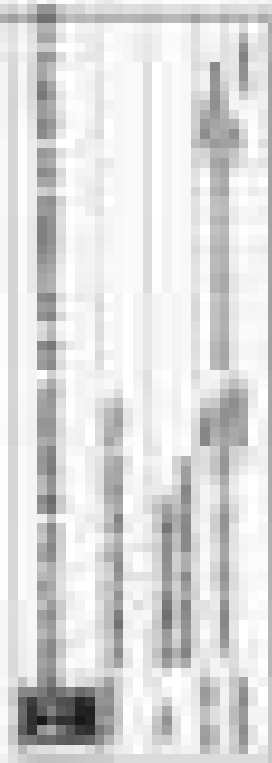
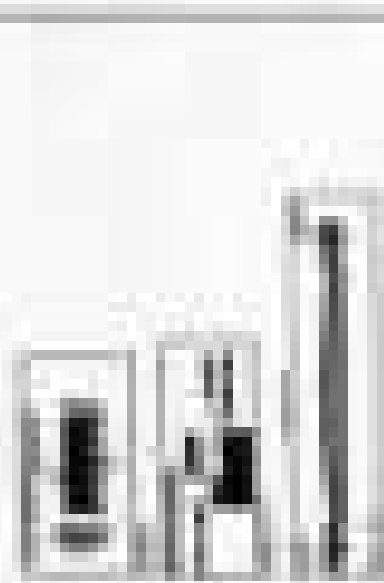
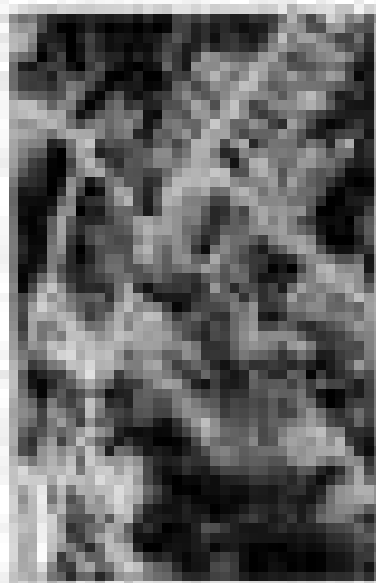


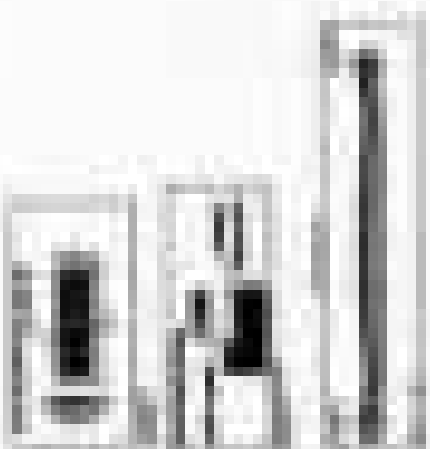
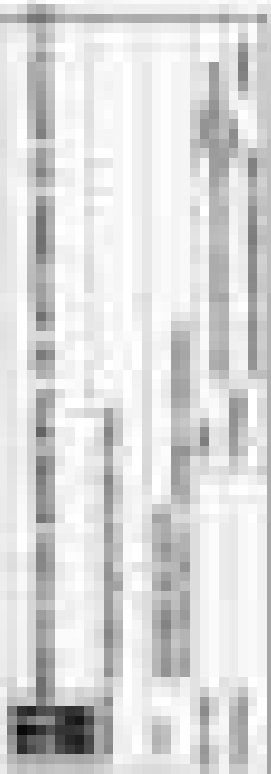
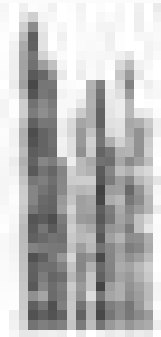
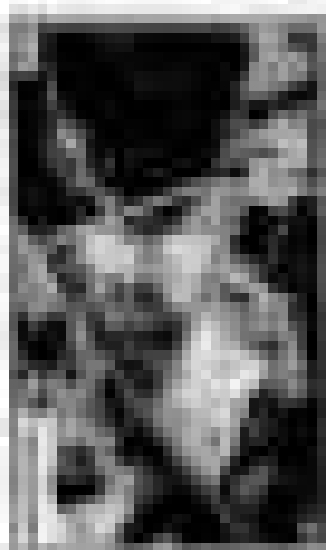


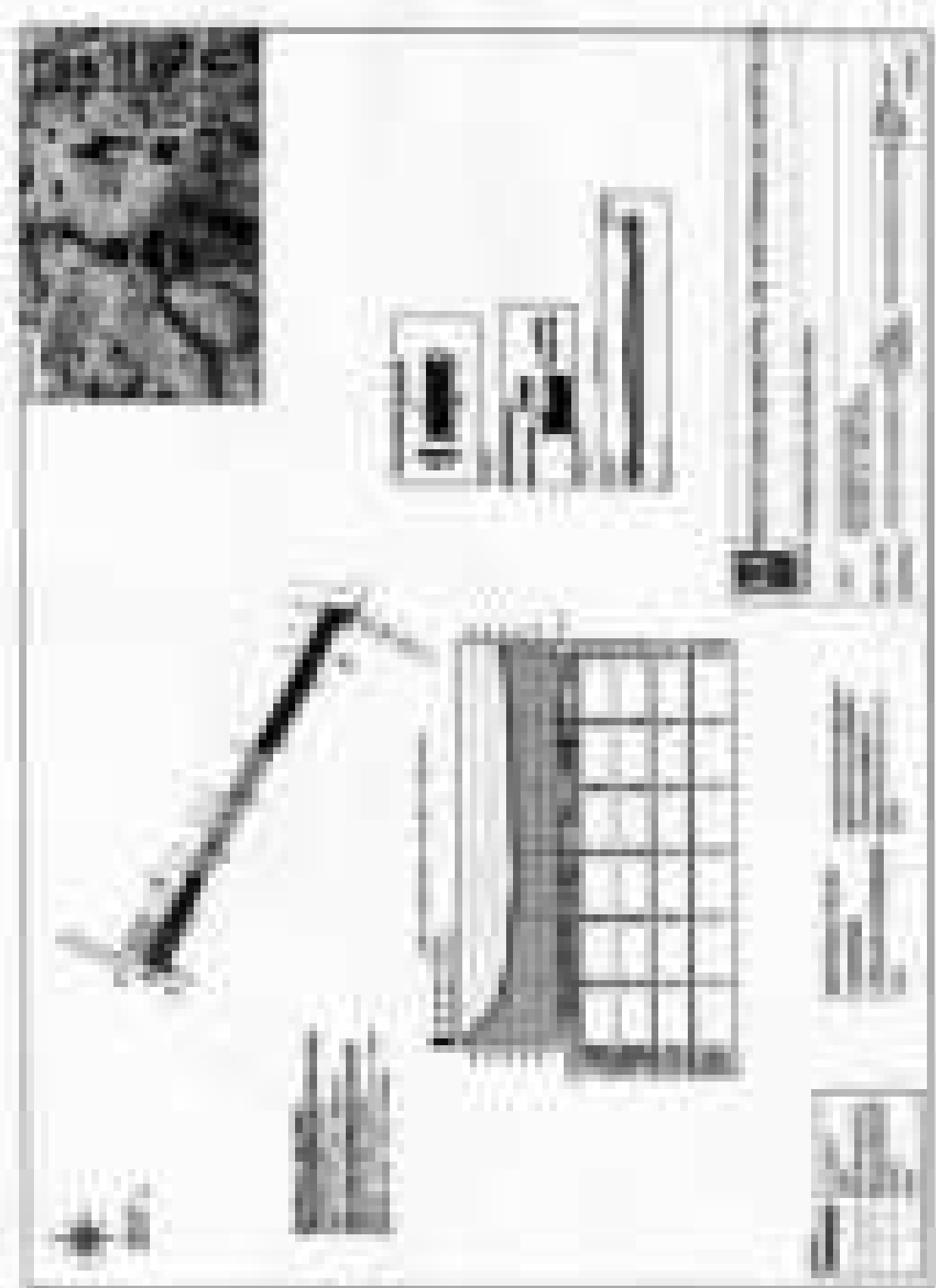


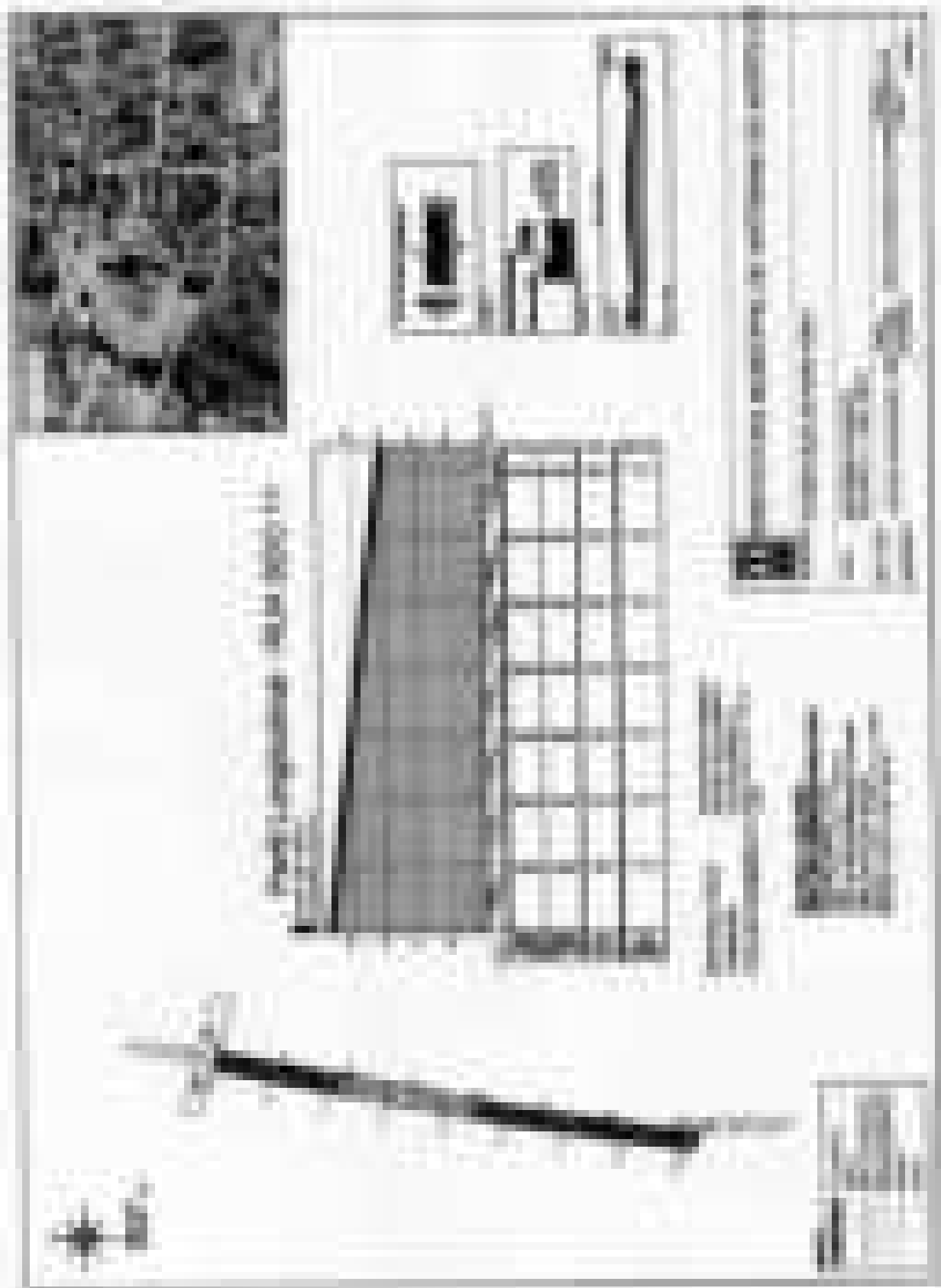


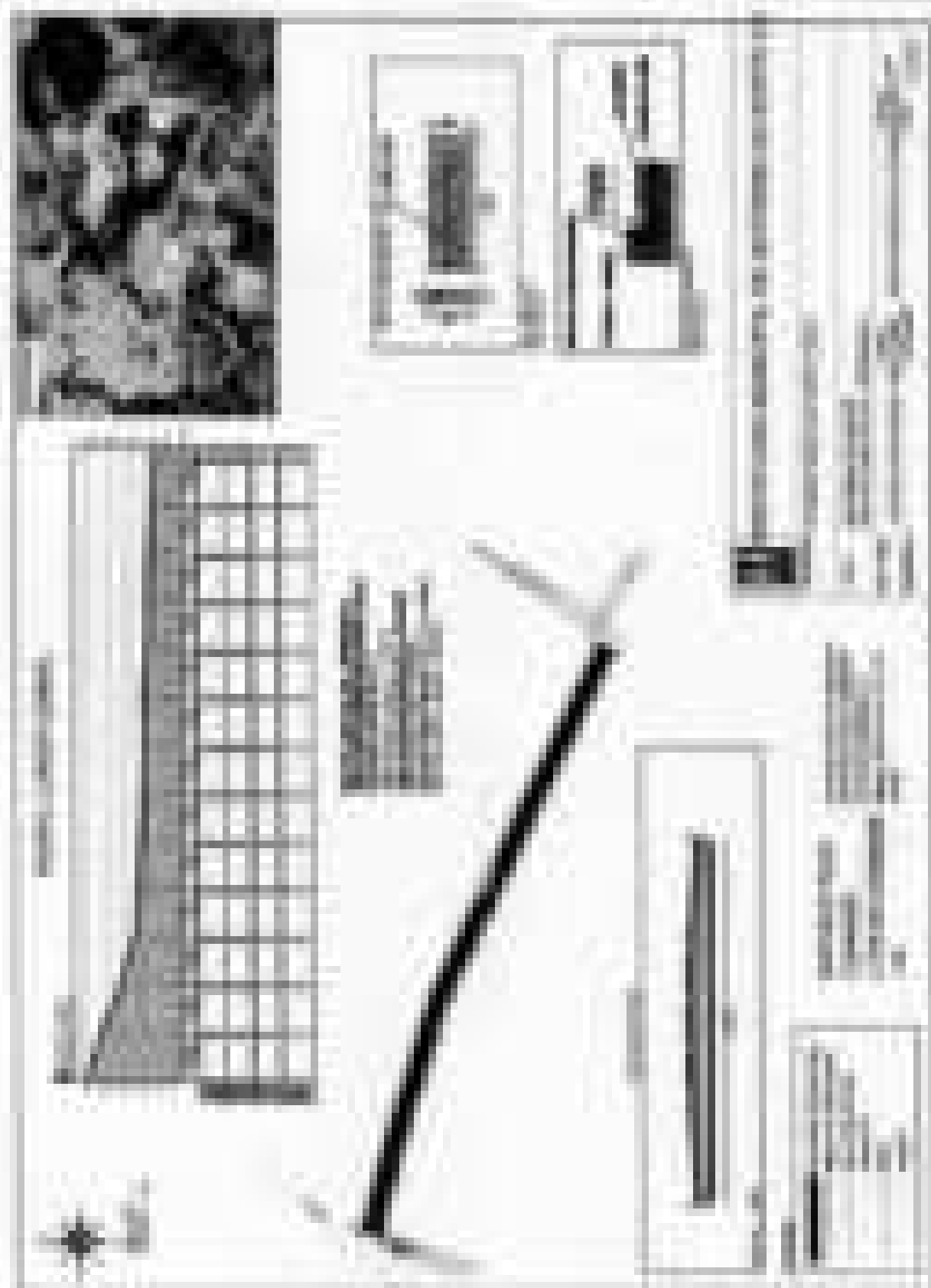


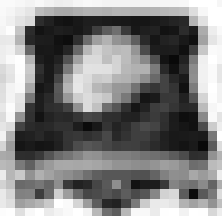
